

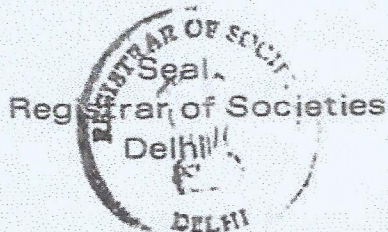

MEMORANDUM OF THE SOCIETY "GODHULI"

1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY GODHULI ✓
2. REGISTERED OFFICE The Registered Office of the Society shall remain in "Delhi" presently at 513, Pocket C, Sector A, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi 110 070. ✓

AIMS AND OBJECTS

As a Charitable Society, to look after the well being of the STREET CHILDREN on the Gandhian principles with special emphasis on the following aspects :-

- a) Providing free education as envisaged in Articles 24 & 45 of the Constitution of India. ✓
- b) Providing one free meal, dress and washing facilities to the children alongwith education in order to encourage them to come for education. ✓
- c) Providing free medical check-up periodically and helping in obtaining primary health services; to undertake special projects relating to all aspects of cancer in children and support such children and their families. ✓
- d) Providing affection, counselling, guidance and national cultural, training to such children so that they become responsible citizens. ✓
- e) After basic education, helping in obtaining vocational training for such children. ✓
- f) Helping and coordinating with other institutions, associations and organisations in educational and other social welfare of street children, such as in adoption of the abandoned and orphan children. ✓
- g) After the Society has attained success in items (a) to (f) above, extending its activities to provide a foster home for the homeless street children. ✓
- h) To do any other act or thing which is ancillary to the achievements of any of the above stated objects. ✓

ANCILLARY OBJECTS :

- i) To acquire by purchase, exchange, mortgage lease, hire or otherwise any moveable or immoveable property for the furtherance of the society. ✓
- ii) To build and maintain buildings and alter, improve or modify the same, including for the furtherance of the Society. ✓

- iv) To appoint staff, to appoint or procure the services of teachers, Masters, Professors, Lecturers, Workers for the furtherance of the Society.
- v) To invest any money of the Institution not immediately required for any of its object in such manner as may be provided by the Constitution of the Institution and as may from time to time be determined.
- vi) To borrow or raise money for any of the above purposes with or without security or on the security of mortgage, charge, hypothecation or pledge of all or any of the immoveable or moveable properties belonging to the Institutions for the furtherance of the Society.
- vii) To manage, control and improve all or any of the properties of the Institution and to sell, exchange, transfer, let-out, lease, mortgage, charge, pledge, hypothecate, or otherwise dispose of any moveable or immoveable property of the Institution or any part thereof for the benefit of the Institution.
- viii) All the incomes, earnings, moveable and immoveable properties of the Society shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit on thereof shall be paid/transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits, or in any manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the Society or to any person claiming through anyone or more of the present or past members. No member of the Society shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immoveable properties of the Society or make any profits what-so-ever by virtue of this membership.
